DCSL Programs and Services

Adult Day Health Programs: This program is designed to provide adults with structured activities, care, and supervision throughout the day. Participants, many of whom are experiencing difficulties associated with dementia, stroke, isolation and confusion, enjoy a safe and comfortable environment while enjoying stimulating activities designed to meet their physical, social, emotional, and mental needs. Activities include crafts, discussion groups, and light exercise for functionally impaired individuals. Registered Nurses are available as needed.

With an additional charge, this program also offers:

- Onsite hair salon called “The CozartXperience Salon at DCSL”

Congregate Meal Program: The Congregate Meal Program is intended to promote social, emotional, and physical well-being in older adults aged 60 years and older. Adults under age 60 with a disability are encouraged to apply with proof of disability. The congregate meal program serves Durham County residents. DCSL provides nutritious hot meals 5 days a week at two satellite senior centers in Durham (see Locations on page 16).

DCSL EATS: DCSL EATS, Easing Access to Food for Seniors, serves residents of Durham County aged 55 and older who are without reliable access to a sufficient amount of affordable, nutritious food. Participants are connected with resources specific to their needs, including referrals to congregate meal sites, assistance enrolling in a meal delivery service, and food pantry referrals. Eligibility may vary for each program.

Family Caregiver Support Program: This program is designed to provide family caregivers with help making caregiving decisions and solving problems related to caregiving. Eligible caregivers are spouses, children, relatives or friends of persons over 55 years and older who have limitations to their activities of daily living and/or significant memory loss. Offerings under this program include:

- Information & Assistance
- Options Counseling
- Powerful Tools for Caregivers evidence based 6-week training
- Respite Care

Health Promotion/Disease Prevention: These evidenced-based programs focus on keeping people active and engaged with their health. These programs aim to empower individuals and communities to choose healthy behaviors and make changes that reduce the risk of developing chronic diseases and other morbidities. Programs consist of exercise classes, lifestyle change programs, and chronic disease self-management programs where participants learn to set and achieve realistic goals to better their daily well-being.

Legal Services: No cost elder law support is offered to seniors several times a year. Dates are listed in the DCSL newsletter. Referrals can be made to the Legal Aid of NC for seniors aged 60 and older. Participants apply and qualify for the legal aid program.

Options Counseling: This program provides guidance to individuals as they make informed choices about long-term services and supports. This service helps people think through the pros and cons of the various options while taking into consideration their situation, values, resources, and preferences. The Options Counselor can also assist with making an action plan for the individual to implement to reach their target goal(s).

Senior Centers: Our senior centers provide exercise and nutrition classes, special events, and educational workshops. Our downtown DCSL location and Little River Satellite site offers exercise classes that are well attended. Some of our classes include aerobics, belly dancing, line dancing, weightlifting and yoga. We also provide specialized classes including Arthritis Foundation Exercise Program, Bingocize, Matter of Balance, Walk with Ease, Tai Chi for Arthritis/Balance/Falls Prevention, and a walking club. A fitness center is provided for individuals that want to work out on their own. Our weekly art offerings include quilting group, crochet club, and water color painting. Movies are shown daily. Most classes are on-going Monday through Friday. Our daily activity calendar is available on our website at www.dcsln.org.

Support Services: Staff help empower seniors to solve complex problems. All assistance is confidential. Services are accessed by phone, in-person, and via e-mail. All requests are recorded and follow up is provided when needed. The agency received many contacts for services related to health issues, food insecurity, housing, utilities, insurance, Medicaid/Medicare application completion, and other areas. These services are designed to reduce barriers to access, increase the knowledge of the senior and assist with implementation of services. This department also helps administer annual programs such as the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) and Operation Fan Heat Relief (OFHR) to clients.

Telephone Reassurance: This program is designed to help homebound elderly and/or disabled individuals to remain independent in their own homes for as long as possible by providing reassuring telephone calls, social support, and safety checks. Trained volunteers make brief and consistent reassurance calls Monday-Friday.

Transportation: DCSL Provides transportation to participants for the congregate meal program at our DCSL at Little River satellite site only. Assistance and referrals to local transportation options is also provided.

Notary Services: Free notary services are available onsite for individuals 55+ who live in Durham County. To learn more or to schedule an appointment, please call 919-688-8247 ext. 103.

PEAS (Providing Elders with Additional Sustenance): This program provides food assistance to high-risk, frail, or functionally impaired older adults age 60 and older through frozen meals. Services are distributed via on-site pick-up, early pickup during closures, and limited home delivery for eligible participants. To learn more or apply, call 919-688-8247 ext. 141.

Choosing Home: Housing & Home Improvement: The Choosing Home program provides financial assistance to help eligible Durham County residents age 60 and older address urgent housing repair, modifications, security enhancements, rental/utility assistance and complete essential home improvements. This is funded by State Fiscal Recovery Funds (SFRF), the program supports vulnerable seniors in maintain a safe, home-based living arrangement and avoid premature transitions to long-term care facilities. Assistance is limited and available only while funds last. To learn more or apply, call 919-688-8247 ext. 141.

External Onsite Organization Rotation: Offsite organizations provide assistance onsite at DCSL during the year. Below is a list of some of the services offered:

Volunteering at DCSL

DCSL offers a variety of short and long-term volunteer opportunities. With numerous opportunities available for individuals and groups, you are sure to find a volunteer option that suits your needs and schedule. Below are ongoing volunteer opportunities.

Class Instructor: Lead weekly exercise or arts and crafts classes or begin a new class! Current exercise classes include yoga, total body workout, Tai' Chi, belly dancing, line dancing, aerobics, and other activities. Current arts and crafts classes include watercolor painting, crocheting, ceramics, jewelry making, and quilting.

Time Commitment: Weekly, Ongoing, and evening opportunities

Lunch & Learn Instructor: Teach an instructional seminar on health/wellness related issues concerning older adults. *Time Commitment: One-Time, Monthly*

Office Assistant: Help with mass mailing, data entry, and filing.

Time Commitment: As Needed/Ongoing

Special Events Committee Member: Help with the planning and facilitation of special events. *Time Commitment: As Needed/Ongoing*

Greeter: Serve as the first point of contact for visitors and members, give facility tours, and orient new members to fitness center, help with publicity and other day-to-day operations.

Time Commitment: Ongoing

Telephone Reassurance: Make phone calls to homebound seniors that live alone.

Time Commitment: Ongoing

Pantry Organizer: Maintain the organization of the DCSL 55+ Food pantry, incontinence supplies, personal care items, and much more. *Time Commitment: ongoing*

Adult Day Health: Assist with the Adult Day Health program by working with seniors during the day to help them remain in their homes with family members.

Time Commitment: Ongoing

North Carolina General Statutes state that a disabled adult aged 18 years or older “shall be in need of protective services if that person, due to physical or mental incapacity, is unable to perform or obtain for himself [herself] essential services and, if that person is without able, responsible, and willing persons to perform or obtain for him [her] essential services.” North Carolina General Statutes further require that “any person having reasonable cause to believe that a disabled adult is in need of protective services, shall report such information” to the County Department of Social Services. Reports can be made anonymously, and DCSL Staff can assist in making referrals.

Reverse mortgage is a loan secured by home equity that does not need to be repaid until the end of the loan term, which is usually when the homeowner can no longer occupy the home as a principal residence, sells the home, or dies. According to a North Carolina statute, you are required to receive counseling from a state-certified housing counselor who will help you understand. If you receive a reverse mortgage, you are still responsible for maintenance, insurance and taxes for the home. To qualify for a reverse mortgage, you and any co-borrower must be at least 62 years old, must own your home, have a very low outstanding debt, and must occupy the home as your primary residence.

Many facilities also have centers for medical care; however, the care offered may not be as intensive or available to residents as the care offered at a nursing home. Assisted living is not an alternative to a nursing home, but an intermediate level of long-term care appropriate for many seniors.
